### **Saturday Seminars**

#### Digital Infrared Photography, Lloyd Chambers

You've seen those beautiful Infrared photography images and wondered how to achieve the effect with a digital camera. Author of the highly rated "Guide To Digital Infrared Photography", Lloyd takes the myth and mystery out of this subject. He will present an overview of how to get started with digital infrared photography with tips and techniques and things to consider when choosing a camera and lens.

The Introduction to Adobe Lightroom will cover the five modules and how they integrate with your workflow as a photographer. You will see how Lightroom can quickl;y manage your library of photographs and how to stay organized while making RAW and JPG adjustments. In Lightroom 3 Tips & Tricks you will be introduced to the top features of the newest version of Lightroom 3-finding images quickly, understanding how to use metadata using keywords, and the latest features in Adobe Camera Raw editor. This latest version gives users new advantages in efficient workflow and image processing - all covered in Nate's lecture.

#### The Art of Bird Photography, Bruce Finocchio

Bring your power of observation and questions to a program filled with wonderful bird images. Bruce will delve into the Art aspects of Bird Photography, including composition, light, backgrounds, and style including capturing birds in flight. The session will include a brief discussion of equipment and the use of camera and flash settings. Be prepared to take away lots of great ideas to incorporate into your style portfolio.

#### Remote Places In Alaska, Oliver Klink

Oliver is a Bay Area wildlife photographer who leads workshops around the world. He acquaints you with how one prepares for photoshoots in remote locations - like Alaska. In Alaska, wilderness is king. You never know what wildlife you will see. Whales, bears, birds, caribous, moose, marine life and also grey wolf, red fox, musk oxen, mountain goats, lynx and many more make their home in Alaska. From a set of images, exciting stories, and photography tips, Oliver will guide you thru his latest photoshoots in Alaska.

### Morroco, Ben Kong

Thinking of Morroco evokes visions of heat and dry deserts but in the winter it is surprisingly cool and lush in many areas. We will benefit from Ben's extensive world travels when he takes us on a breath-taking photographic tour of Morroco from Casablanca, to Meknes, Fez, Erfoud, Merzouga, Quarzazate, Marrakesh, camping in the Sahara Desert, and to Adadir watching goats eating nuts on top of Argen trees. With an emphasis on simple and concise composition, we will see Ben's compositions of balanced colors, lines, and forms which have a hint of abstraction; strong yet soothing.

### Polar Bears of Churchill, Manitoba - A Photographer's Perspective, Jim Liskovec

Listen to Jim speak of how he and his wife Sue developed a love of the natural world. How becoming world travellers made them keen observers and photographers of birds, mammals, and other wildlife. And how this love of nature drew them to photograph the Polar Bears of Churchill, Manitoba, on the shores of Hudson Bay. Jim will present his eight-day "up-close" adventure photographing the Polar Bears but also Arctic fox, Arctic hare, willow ptarmigan as well as others. See the bears unique adaptations to the fierce cold and how Arctic warming threatens their survival.
